

Map Your Ride Activity

Overview

Maps play an important role in any outdoor event. The 2022 UCI Road World Championships is mapped over three main courses, the Helensburgh Start, the Mount Keira Loop and the Wollongong City Circuit This activity asks students to map a bike ride for their family, inspired by the course.

Approximate duration: 1.5 hours

Resources needed:

- iPad or Computer
- Google My Maps (or equivalent mapping software)

Instructions

1. View [2022 UCI Road World Championship course map overview here](#).
2. Ask students to locate their home on Google My Maps (or equivalent mapping software) and map a bike ride for their family. Get them to think about where they will be riding (i.e. on the road or bike track), how long they will be riding for, and the elevation throughout their ride.
3. Once the map is made, get students to plan their ride

Tips/Suggested Reading

- When planning their ride, get students to consider the following: the prep work that goes into a ride (i.e. bike maintenance), if they need to pack snacks, will they have a pit stop to rest
